**To install or replace the Bite-Lite® Biting Insect Lure for use with the Bite-Lite® H-Trap Professional Horse Fly Control System, please follow these simple steps.**

1. Open the foil bag of the Bite-Lite® Biting Insect Lure.
2. Cut any type of string, twine, etc. to a length of about 25 inches.
3. Thread one end of the string through the hole at the top of the lure cartridge and secure it tightly.
4. Attach the other end of the string to either the H-Trap hook or ball loop.
5. For best results, the lure should hang just below the bottom of the green hood.
6. Replace the lure every 30 - 60 days depending on ambient temperature.
